LIFT LENGTHS AND DROPS

Lift 1 ascends to the tree line on Kaunispää. Lift 3 is a practice lift. The slopes are gentle. Lifts 4 and 5 ascend to the top of lisakkipää. Lift 6 ascends to the top of Kaunispää.

Saariselkä is a ski resort in northern Lapland with slopes on two fells, Kaunispää and lisakkipää. These vary from very easy to difficult and have something to offer skiers of all levels.
