- Maximum drop 180 m

- Finland's longest park (1200 m). Near the top is a corner which is 4 m high and 20 m long. This is followed by different rails with jumps. The slope includes three large jumps (4-5 m) and 1-3 boxes (about 3 m).

1	1000 m	180 m
3	100 m	35 m
4	800 m	160 m
5	800 m	160 m
6	1300 m	180 m

Lift 1 ascends to the tree line on Kaunispää.
Lift 3 is a practice lift. The slopes are gentle.
Lifts 4 and 5 ascend to the top of Iisakkipää.
Lift 6 ascends to the top of Kaunispää.
